



Maryland: Your Partner in Exporting

Exports from Maryland reached a record high of \$12.2 billion in 2014, up from \$11.8 billion in 2013. More than 7,000 Maryland businesses export to 209 countries, supporting 59,560 U.S. jobs. Record cargo levels at the Port of Baltimore and expansion plans at BWI are growing Maryland's international footprint, creating more jobs and more opportunities for Maryland businesses.

Maryland companies that receive the ExportMD Stipend may be eligible for up to \$10,000 in reimbursement for expenses associated with export development initiatives. In addition, to assist with executing these initiatives, companies can also receive up to 40 hours of assistance from OIIT's offices, located in 9 countries around the globe.
